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# Alley-gate Analysis Nancroft Mount

**Safer Leeds**  
*tackling drugs and crime*

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### **Important Information**

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### **Methodology**

This profile is an evaluation of crime and incidents in order to assess the effectiveness of alley-gates in a specific area.

Crime and Incident data for this profile includes the dates 01/12/07 – 30/11/09, taken from CORVUS.

There are some data issues with ASB incident data. A change of recording systems may have affected the figures and therefore any ASB incident data totals recorded before April 2008 may be incorrect.

The data totals were collated for Leeds, the ward the alley-gate has been installed in, and the street the alley-gate has been installed in. Any changes in trend have then been advised.

### **Context**

This report looks at a current alley-gating scheme for the following streets:

Nancroft Mount

The scheme was introduced during December 2008 and the data looks at the years before and after installation.

The area of Leeds has seen an overall reduction in total crime (-6%) when comparing the periods Dec 07 to November 08 and December 08 to November 09.

Increases in crime were seen when comparing the months of December, March and May.

Ward 4 saw increases in total crime for December to May, with the exception of February. The remainder of the year saw decreases. This has meant that when comparing the total offences in a year before and a year after the alley-gate installation, there appears to be no change in overall crime levels.

Data for Nancroft Mount shows a reduction of two offences when looking at the data periods. There is no particular peak month, however September 2008 saw an issue where 5 offences were recorded.

Further analysis of crime types, shows that the street has not suffered from any specific recorded crime type over the two year period analysed.

5 Damage to Motor Vehicles, 4 of which occurred consecutively in September 2008 and wing mirrors were kicked off of vehicles on the road.

included in the data were 3 Burglaries and 3 Theft From Motor Vehicle.

Data for Anti-Social behaviour shows that ward 4 has seen a 2% increase in Anti-social behaviour over the months May – November, there is no trend within the months. ASB data on Nancroft Mount does not indicate any particular trend and numbers are too low to enable any meaningful analysis.

The 9 Anti-Social Behaviour incidents include four calls regarding issues between neighbours. The other calls are regarding nuisance youths causing problems on the streets.
