Methodology

This profile is an evaluation of crime and incidents in order to assess the effectiveness of alleygates in a specific area.

Crime and Incident data for this profile includes the dates 01/11/07 - 30/10/09, taken from CORVUS.

There are some data issues with ASB incident data. A change of recording systems may have affected the figures and therefore any ASB incident data totals recorded before April 2008 may be incorrect.

The data totals were collated for Leeds, the ward the alley-gate has been installed in, and the street the alley-gate has been installed in. Any changes in trend have then been advised.

<u>Context</u>

This report looks at a current alley-gating scheme for the following streets:

Oakham Way

The scheme was introduced during November 2008 and the data looks at the years before and after installation.

Total crime data for Leeds shows that there has been an overall reduction in offences when comparing 12 months before and 12 months after the alley-gate was installed. This reduction has been continuous since June 2009. Ward 7 reflects the decrease seen in total Leeds data. Total crime data suggests that when comparing the 12 month periods before and after the alley-gate installation, there has been a reduction in offences on the street. This reflects the trend for the City and ward areas.

Crime type data shows reductions across the comparative years. The main offence seen on the street is burglary.

ASB data for May to October shows that there has been an increase of ASB in ward 7 when comparing the 12 month periods.

Data for Oakham Way shows that ASB incidents have been recorded over the previous 12 months, which had not been the case over the 07to08 period.

There have been 5 calls of anti-social behaviour in the previous two years and they have all occurred after the alley-gate has been installed. Two calls are regarding individuals in drink, one call is regarding an abandoned vehicle, another is a domestic issue and finally, one call has no description.
