1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 At the 6th of May 2009 Adult Social Care Scrutiny Board meeting members expressed their concern at the lack of support for those individuals detained under the Mental Health Act and then discharged into the community. At the meeting on the 17th of June 2009 the Board further agreed that an inquiry be conducted into this matter and incorporated into the 2009/10 work programme.
- 1.2 The Board established a working group to undertake aspects of the inquiry. The first meeting of the working group took place on the 19th October 2009. Since that date three further meeting have taken place.
