## Area Committees

Within each Committee's area:

## (Council functions)

- to make Elected Member<sup>1</sup> appointments<sup>2</sup> to Outside Bodies as determined by the Member Management Committee;
- 2. to advise or make representations to the Council, the Executive Board, Scrutiny Boards or Regulatory Panels on all matters affecting community interests;<sup>3</sup>
- 3. to consider and respond to consultations on planning briefs and frameworks and on major development proposals affecting the Committee's area;<sup>4</sup>
- to consider proposals referred to the Committee by the Council, Executive Board, Scrutiny Boards or Regulatory Panels and to report back the Committee's views to the referring body;<sup>5</sup>
- 5. to receive and hear deputations;
- 6. to consider the performance, targeting, frequency and co-ordination of services and make recommendations to the Executive Board as appropriate;<sup>6</sup>

## (Executive functions)7

- 7. to promote and improve the economic, social and environmental well-being of the Committee's area<sup>8</sup>;
- 8. to exercise Area Functions;9
