These will be made available at the request of an authorised officer. |

| 6 | a) Each socket-outlet circuit shall be protected by a residual current device having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA. |
| | b) Each individual socket-outlet shall be protected by an integral residual current device having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA. |
| | The current operation of all residual current devices shall be checked regularly by pressing the test button. If the device does not switch off the supply, an electrical contractor should be consulted. At the same time action should be taken to prohibit the use of socket outlets associated with a faulty residual current device. |
| | Public Safety 6 :- General Housekeeping |
| X | Safety-glass that is impact resistant should be used wherever-possible in-all-areas where the public may come into contact with it. Where it is not used in public areas, glazing should be shielded to protect it from impact. |
| Ŝ | A written spillage policy will be kept to ensure spillages are dealt with in a timely and safe manner |
| | Public Safety 7 :- Refreshments |
| 9 | Members of the public will be prevented from accessing hot food and drink preparation areas to prevent risk of scalds or burns to them. |
