


LEGAL NOTICE

FOR THE DISPERSAL OF GROUPS AND REMOVAL OF PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 TO THEIR HOME ADDRESS

West Yorkshire Police and the Local Authority have both agreed that there are grounds to believe that members of the public have been intimidated, harassed, alarmed or distressed as a result of the presence or behaviour of two or more persons, and that anti-social behaviour is a significant and persistent problem in the locality detailed below:

RELEVANT LOCALITY:

Harehills Lane, Coldcotes Avenue, Harehills Park Terrace, Foundry Approach, Foundry Place, Strathmore Drive, Berkeley Crescent, Berkeley View Chatsworth Road, Sandhurst Avenue, Allotments, St Wilfrid's Drive, Hovingham Avenue, Hovingham Park, track to rear of Hovingham School, Allotments, Ryan Place, Hovingham Avenue



RELEVANT PERIOD: From: 2 July 2010 To: 1 October 2010

I, Timothy Kingsman, Superintendent, West Yorkshire Police, with the consent of Leeds City Council, being the relevant Local Authority, hereby authorise uniformed Constables and Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs) to disperse groups as defined under Part 4 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Act 2003 from the above area during the relevant period detailed above:

DIRECTIONS:

During the period specified above, a Constable or PCSO in uniform may give one or more of the following directions:

- Tell people in the group to leave the area (either immediately, or at a stated time and in a stated way).
- Tell people who don't live in the area to leave (either immediately, or at a stated time and in a stated way).
- Tell people who don't live in the area not to return to the area, or any part of it, for such period (not exceeding 24 hours) from when the direction was given, as specified.

IF YOU ARE UNDER 16:

You are not allowed to be in this locality between the hours of **9pm and 6am**, unless you are under the effective control of a parent or responsible person over the age of 18.

You may be removed to your home, or place of safety if more appropriate.

TAKE NOTE:

To remain in, or return to, this area having been told to leave, may be an offence under Section 30(4) of the Anti-Social Behaviour Act 2003, punishable by 3 months imprisonment and / or a fine of up to £5000.
