Executive Summary

A request has been received from the Clerk to the Trustees for the Area Committee to consider an appointment of a Trustee on this charity.

1.0 Purpose Of This Report

This registered charity (No. 1059263) is one of the local appointments which is delegated to this Area Committee by the Member Management Committee.

2.0 Background Information

The stated purpose of the charity is the relief of financial hardship within the Ancient Parish of Barwick in Elmet. Trustees do not have to be City Councillors, and since 2003 the Council's representative, appointed via this Area Committee, has been Mr Jack Anderson. Mr Anderson is an ex-employee of Social Services, and his contribution to the charity is regarded by them as invaluable and they hold him in high regard.

His four year term of office is due to expire in April 2011, and the charity are requesting the Area Committee to consider re-appointing Mr Anderson for a further term.

3.0 Implications For Council Policy and Governance

This is one of the appointments which falls into the Community and Local Engagement category of Council appointments to outside bodies, delegated to this Area Committee.

4.0 Legal and Resource Implications

There are no legal or resource implications in the proposed re-appointment.
