The application premises are situated in a predominantly residential area and lie immediately adjacent to the residential properties. The patron's car park is located opposite the site on the junction of Belle Vue Avenue and North Lane. The premises comprise a medium sized functions room and board games room on the ground floor level and snooker room on the upper floor level. There is no provision for air conditioning at the premises; there will be the tendency to open the windows for ventilation during the summer months. All the windows are, however, doubly glazed which will be beneficial to contain an entertainment noise breaking out.

In the rear yard of the premises are 4 compressors (beer coolers) which are thermostatically controlled and operated throughout the night. At the time of my visit the compressors were operating and in my opinion have the potential to give rise to nuisance complaints from the occupier of an adjoining residential property especially during the night time but there have been no records of such complaints made to the Department.

The applicant is seeking to extend the times for the supply of alcohol until 01:00 hours and Regulated entertainment (performance of live music & recorded music, dancing & making music etc) until midnight. I was advised by the applicant that it is their intention to operate the premises largely within the existing timetables; however, they are seeking to extend the closing times of the premises and licensable activities to allow more flexibility for their members during the special occasions / parties.

Having considered the application for this premises, the Leeds City Council's Environmental Action Service considers that the following measures are proportionate and necessary in order to promote the Prevention of Public Nuisance objective of the Licensing Act 2003.

### **Noise and Vibration**

- 1. Noise from a licensable activity at the premises will not be audible at the nearest noise sensitive premises which are situated on Belle Vue Avenue and North Lane.
- 2. Ensure all doors and windows are kept closed to reduce noise nuisance from the premises when regulated entertainment takes place.
- 3. Bottles will not be placed in any external receptacle between 11 pm and 7 am the following day to minimise noise disturbance to neighbouring properties.
- 4. Noise from plant or machinery shall not be audible at the nearest noise sensitive premises (which are situated immediately to the rear) during the operation of the plant or machinery. Plant and machinery shall be regularly serviced and maintained to meet this level.

5. The activities of persons using the external areas (for smoking) shall be monitored and they shall be reminded to have regard to the needs of local residents and to refrain from shouting and anti social behaviour etc when necessary.

6. The PLH/DPS will adopt a "cooling down" period where music volume is reduced towards the closing time of the premises.

#### Litter

7. The PLH/DPS shall ensure that litter arising from people using the premises is cleared away regularly and that promotional materials such as flyers do not create litter.

## **Transport / Pedestrian Movement**

- 8. Clear and legible notices will be displayed at exits, car parks and other circulatory areas requesting patrons to leave the premises quietly having regard to the needs of local residents, in particular emphasising the need to refrain from shouting, slamming car doors, sounding horns and loud use of vehicle stereos and anti-social behaviour.
- 9. A facility will be provided for customers to order hackney taxis/private hire vehicles. Telephone numbers for taxi firms/private hire companies will be displayed in a prominent position on the premises.
