Dear Sir or Madam

We would like to submit our official objection to the licence application by the above premises. We object on the following grounds.

- The opening hours are excessive, with the premises requesting to operate long after any other business in the area, including bars.
- There are residential properties nearby and we feel that opening until 3am at the weekend will have a detrimental effect on local residents with excessive noise levels from the premises and customers.
- Permitting this type of premises to remain open to such a late hour after the local bars have closed will encourage revellers to congregate in the area increasing the chance of public nuisance and antisocial behaviour.
- It will increase the problem of litter and associated mess in the immediate area and surrounding residential streets.
