I am writing on behalf of the CANPlan Steering Committee in relation to the above License Applications.

We are aware of the Cumulative Impact Policy which relates to pubs, clubs, bars, café bars, restaurants and takeaways. There are already problems with litter and traffic in Stainbeck Lane. These problems are worst late at night, in darkness, as the bars close.

We object to the idea that these takeaways can extend their business times, and in particular that Jaldi Jaldi would be open until the early morning of the next day. This might encourage late night eating for those visitors who come to Chapel Allerton to drink, but it would cause problems for the local community both late at night and the next morning due to litter and traffic.

In the CANPlan Community Plan and Design Statement, which is now a Supplementary Planning Document, one of the Community Aspirations is 'to promote policy, including additional planning policy, to limit the concentration of bars and licensed premises in Chapel Allerton and to promote a wide-ranging shopping area full of character'.
