Summary of main issues

3.1 The applicant is Mrs Aisha Bulbulia,

3.3.1 Sale by Retail of Alcohol for consumption off the Premises :

Monday – Saturday 06:00 - 23:00

Sunday 08:00 - 23:00

3.3.2 Times when the Premises will be open to the public:

Monday – Saturday 06:00 - 24:00

Sunday 08:00 - 24:00

4.0 Other matters relevant to the application

4.1 At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the Licensing Sub-Committee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.

5.0 Steps to promote the Licensing Objectives

6.0 Proposed Designated Premises Supervisor

6.1 Amarjit Jhagra intends to be the Designated Premises Supervisor.

7.0 Location

8.0 Representations

8.5 Representations from Interested parties

8.5.1 The application has attracted representations from Interested Parties

8.5.2 The Licensing Section is in receipt of two letters which are on the grounds of anti-social behavior and noise.

8.5.3 Copies of the representations will be available at the hearing for Members consideration.

9.0 Options Available to Members

9.1 The Licensing sub-committee must take such of the following steps as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- Grant the application as requested.
- Grant the application whilst imposing additional conditions and/or altering in any way the proposed operating schedule.
- Exclude any licensable activities to which the application relates.
- Refuse to specify the said person as the designated premises supervisor.
- Reject the whole or part of the application.

9.2 Members of the licensing sub committee are asked to note that they may not modify the conditions or reject the whole or part of the application merely because it considers it desirable to do so. It must actually be necessary in order to promote the licensing objectives.
