

Studies have identified a larger than expected number of accidents involving pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles occurred on Roundhay Road compared to similar roads elsewhere in Leeds. Several of these occurred at or near the Shepherd's Lane junction.

Metro and the bus operators have identified Roundhay Road northbound as a major source of delay for buses in the busy afternoon period.

What is being proposed?

Inside this leaflet you will find a plan showing our draft proposals, which include traffic signals at the Shepherds Lane junction, measures to assist pedestrians, a joint pedestrian/cycle crossing and a bus and cycle lane to operate during the busy afternoon period, with restrictions to other traffic at these times.
