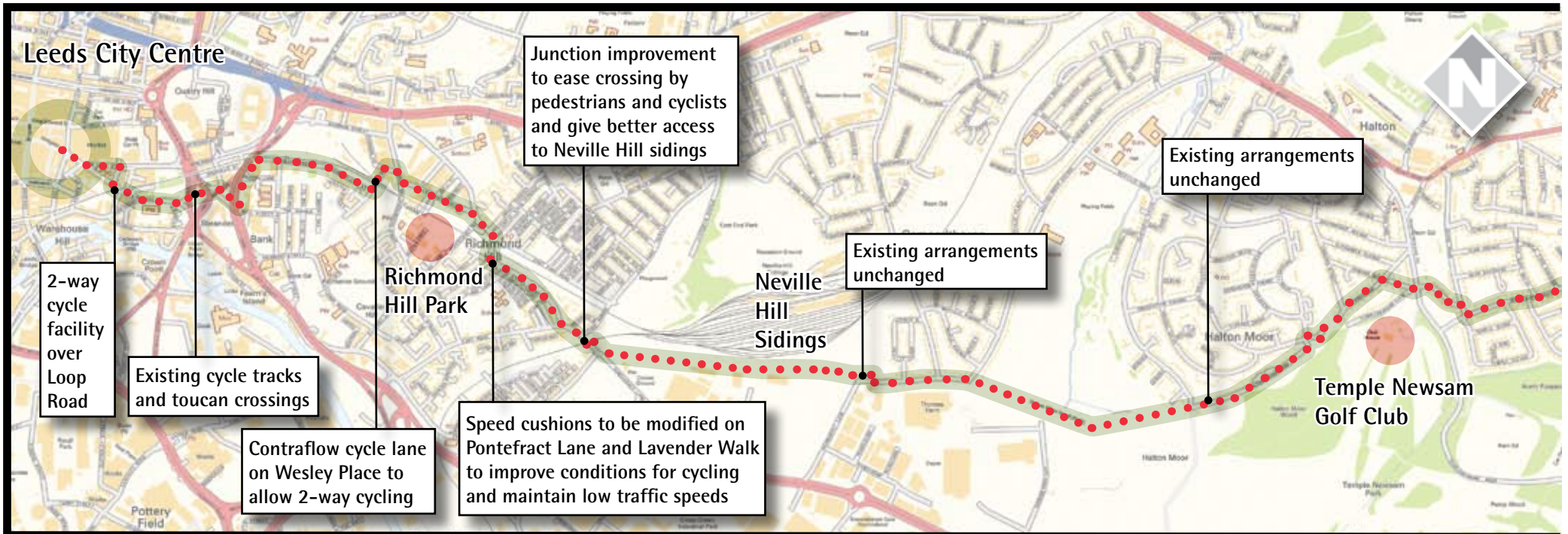
Public Consultation

The Garforth to City Centre Cycle Route forms part of the Leeds Core Cycle Network. The LCCN is a network of 17 routes designed to help encourage cycling to work, to school and for leisure purposes.

The route will be signed and use a combination of cycle lanes, tracks, quiet roads and junction improvements to provide a continuous route between Garforth, Colton, Halton, Richmond Hill and the City Centre suitable for use by novice and regular cyclists.

Works will be funded as part of Leeds City Council's successful Local Sustainable Transport Fund Bid.
