Summary of main issues

This is an application for the grant of a premises licence for a temporary marquee within a Car Park in the grounds of Temple Newsam Park, Templenewsam Road, Halton, Leeds, LS15 0AD as indicated on the map at Appendix C

The application is for Live music, Recorded music, Performance of dance, Provision of facilities for dancing, Late night refreshment, Sale by retail of alcohol as noted in 3.3

1.0 Purpose of this Report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") for a premises licence in respect of the above mentioned premises.

2.0 History of Premises

- 2.1 This is the first application of this type for this location.
- 2.2 The application is for a time limited Premises Licence between Friday 30th November 2012 and Saturday 22nd December 2012

Late Night Refreshment

Everyday 23:00 – 01:00

This application is for a time limited period 30.11.2012 to 22.12.2012

4.0 Other matters relevant to the application

- 4.1 This application is for a temporary marquee within a Car Park in the grounds of Temple Newsam Park. The applicants are planning to erect a marquee upon this land and conduct private and corporate Christmas parties for up to 15 nights between 30th November 2012 to 23rd December 2012 with a maximum of 950 guests at any one night.
- 4.2 At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the Licensing Sub-Committee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003

5.0 Steps to promote the Licensing Objectives

8.0 Representations

9.0 Options Available to Members

9.1 The Licensing sub-committee must take such of the following steps as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- Grant the application as requested.
- Grant the application whilst imposing additional conditions and/or altering in any way the proposed operating schedule.
- Exclude any licensable activities to which the application relates.
- Refuse to specify the said person as the designated premises supervisor.
- Reject the whole or part of the application.

9.2 Members of the licensing sub committee are asked to note that they may not modify the conditions or reject the whole or part of the application merely because it considers it desirable to do so. It must actually be necessary in order to promote the licensing objectives.
