We have a dedicated marketing team who promote all our events and we do not use aggressive on street promotion teams

b) The prevention of crime & disorder

We use a security firm (BigTeam Security) to assist in providing SIA door security staff to secure our venue in terms of Door supervision;

The Security Staff will be fully uniformed by wearing the correct clothing, this could be high visibility vests/jackets or plain black dinner jackets. These security procedures ensure troublemakers and minors are turned away; so that our patrons enjoy a safe and secure environment.

On the unfortunate occasions where an incident may occur, we can be assured of the high standard and professionalism in which the matter is dealt with by our security staff. In such situations we will establish protocols that include the completion of an appropriate incident report for both our own records and for the local authorities.

c) Public safety

Our venue will meet health and safety guidelines as set out by a site visit by HSE

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We will not allow patrons to congregate outside the premises with alcohol and will clearly display signs stating that people should be quiet when leaving our premises. We will not allow stag groups or large parties of people to gain admittance to our venue. Our security firm have already started working closely with the others security firms in the street to work together in keeping the area safe for all

We will not allow under 18's into our premises.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on conviction for this offence is a fine not exceeding £5,000
