Summary of main issues

 The Scrutiny Board (Regeneration) has now completed its inquiry on affordable housing by private developers. The Working Group comprising all Members of the Board has met on several occasions since early November 2011. A small group of Members from the Board also held a telecommunications meeting with a financial institution on 24th April 2012 which was extremely valuable. The Board is now in a position to report on its findings and its conclusions and recommendations resulting from the evidence that has been gathered.

Draft Inquiry Report

2 The Board only completed its inquiry on 24th April 2012 and the timescale for the clearance of the Board's report with the relevant Directorates is extremely tight. A copy of the draft final report along with a summary of the evidence considered during the inquiry will therefore be circulated for members consideration as soon as possible.

Consultation

3 Scrutiny Board Procedure Rule 13.2 states that "where a Scrutiny Board is considering making specific recommendations it shall invite advice from the appropriate Director(s) prior to finalising its recommendations.
