To whom it may concern,

Please accept this email, as an objection by West Yorkshire Police to the application for a sex establishment licence, made by Razwan Ali for premises known as The Black Diamond Club situated at 68 New Briggate Leeds 1.

The basic grounds for the objection are:-

1. after the service of a Closure Notice under section 19 of the Criminal Justice & Police Act 2001 on the 6th April 2012, the alleged unauthorised use of the premises as identified on the notice, remain unresolved at the time of serving this objection; and
2. other previous issues relating to these premises, this being the fourth such S.19 Closure Notice served on the premises since August 2010;

where clearly there is a repetitive tendency, to ignore the requirement to comply with the conditions of other existing licences, but which are also relevant to this type of licence application.

Further information will be provided by West Yorkshire Police with regards to this objection, nearer to the hearing itself.
