Summary of main issues

1. To complement the 2011/12 Quarter 4 performance report presented elsewhere on the agenda, attached at Appendix 1 is the most recent NHS Airedale, Bradford and Leeds (NHS ABL) performance report, presented to the NHS ABL Cluster Board at its meeting on 24 May 2012.
2. The attached report provides an overview of performance against key performance indicators for both NHS Leeds and NHS Bradford and Airedale (i.e. the constituent Primary Care Trusts of the NHS ABL Cluster). The report highlights the key performance issues facing the Cluster organisation and, on this occasion, shows a partial evolution toward the 2012/13 Operating Framework, whilst also showing end of year data for 2011/12.
