## **Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence
  - a. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph; date of birth and a holographic mark.

### **Embedded Restrictions**

4. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during the hours stated on this licence and:
  - a. On Christmas Day, 12 noon to 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.
  - b. On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).
5. The above restrictions do not prohibit:
  - a. the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of alcohol so ordered;
  - b. the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club.

#### **The prevention of crime and disorder**

6. Adopt the Check 21 proof of age scheme in accordance with guidance issued by West Yorkshire Police or other approved proof of age scheme.
7. Operate and maintain the existing CCTV system to record throughout operating hours.

## **Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

### **Public safety**

8. The Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that written records of all accidents and safety incidents involving members of the public are kept. The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that these will be made available at the request of an authorised officer.

9. The Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that safety glass that is impact resistant should be used wherever possibly in all areas where the public may come into contact with it. Where it is not used in public areas glazing should be shielded to protect it from impact.
10. The Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that all floor surfaces will be suitably slip resistant, kept in good conditions and free of obstructions to prevent slips, trips and falls.
11. The Designated Supervisor will ensure that where strobes, lasers, smoke machines or any other special effects equipment may be used a written health and safety policy covering all aspects of their use will be provided. The Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that staff will be appropriately trained on the policy.
