

When the problems were on going we had threats, against us, had 3 mobility cars, damaged one of them was so bad I was without it for 3mths whilst it was in the repair shop, I had all my Koi Carp fish poisoned, our garden was ~~so~~ damaged the list was endless. Then we heard that a company called KASA was by looking at buying the pub & turning into something that would benefit the whole community. We worked alongside the brothers namely Adeel Bashir, Akeel Bashir, they kept us upto date with everything that was happening. I believe.

~~that~~ that this store along with the bargain shop & the special one take-away are just what Belle-Isle needs. It is only the minority of people who are & have been against Kasa's since the Grey Goose closed & they are the ones who used to cause mayhem when the pub was open. Kasa's sponsor the local kids for boxing & Rugby tournaments etc. I also believe that they sponsor roundabout at the top of Belle-Isle road.

If there is a problem with youths congregating outside the shops this cannot be blamed onto the shop assistants. These youths are very intimidating as I know only too well from first hand experience. If Kasa's
