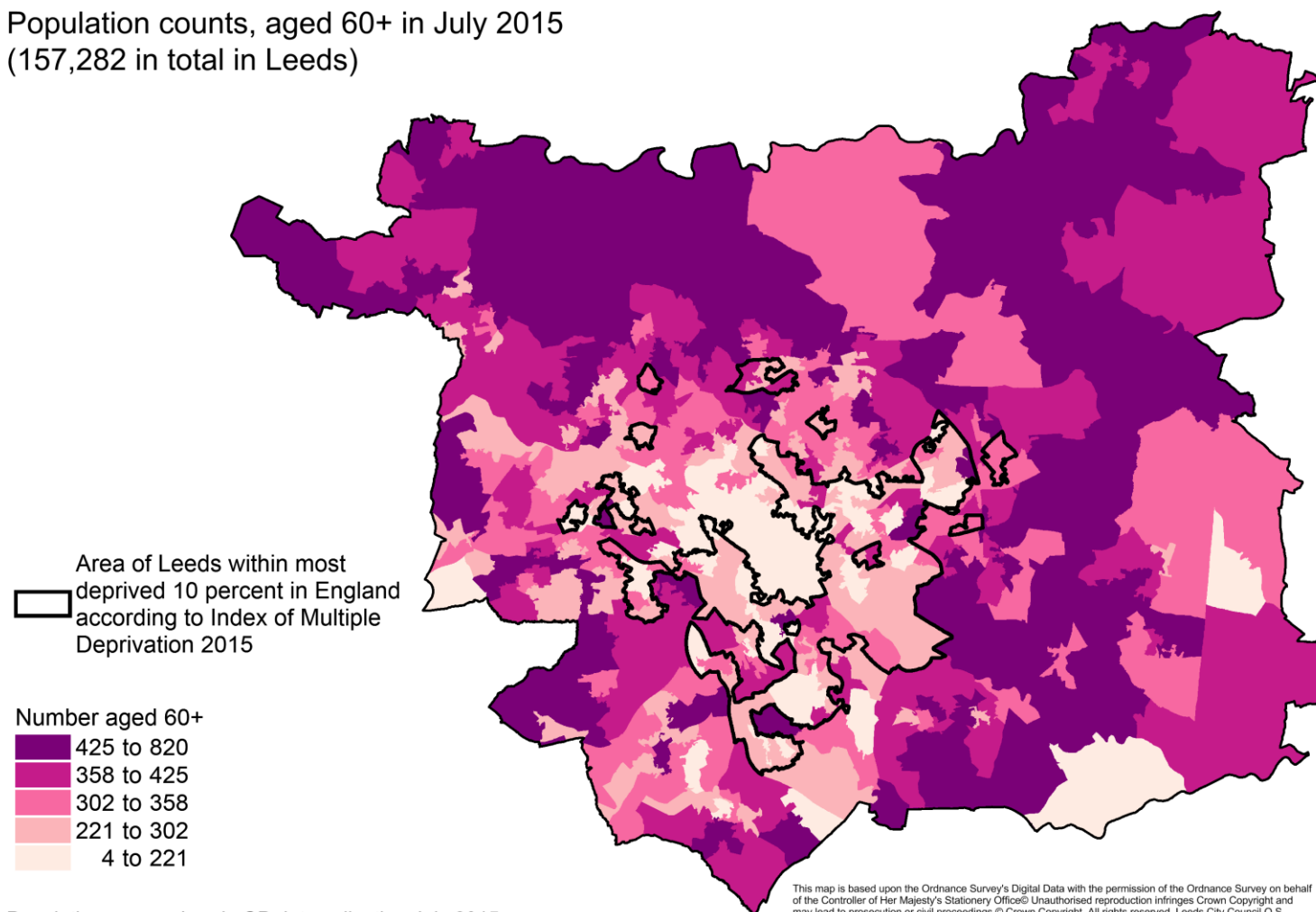


Population counts, aged 60+ in July 2015

7 others are inside the top 500.

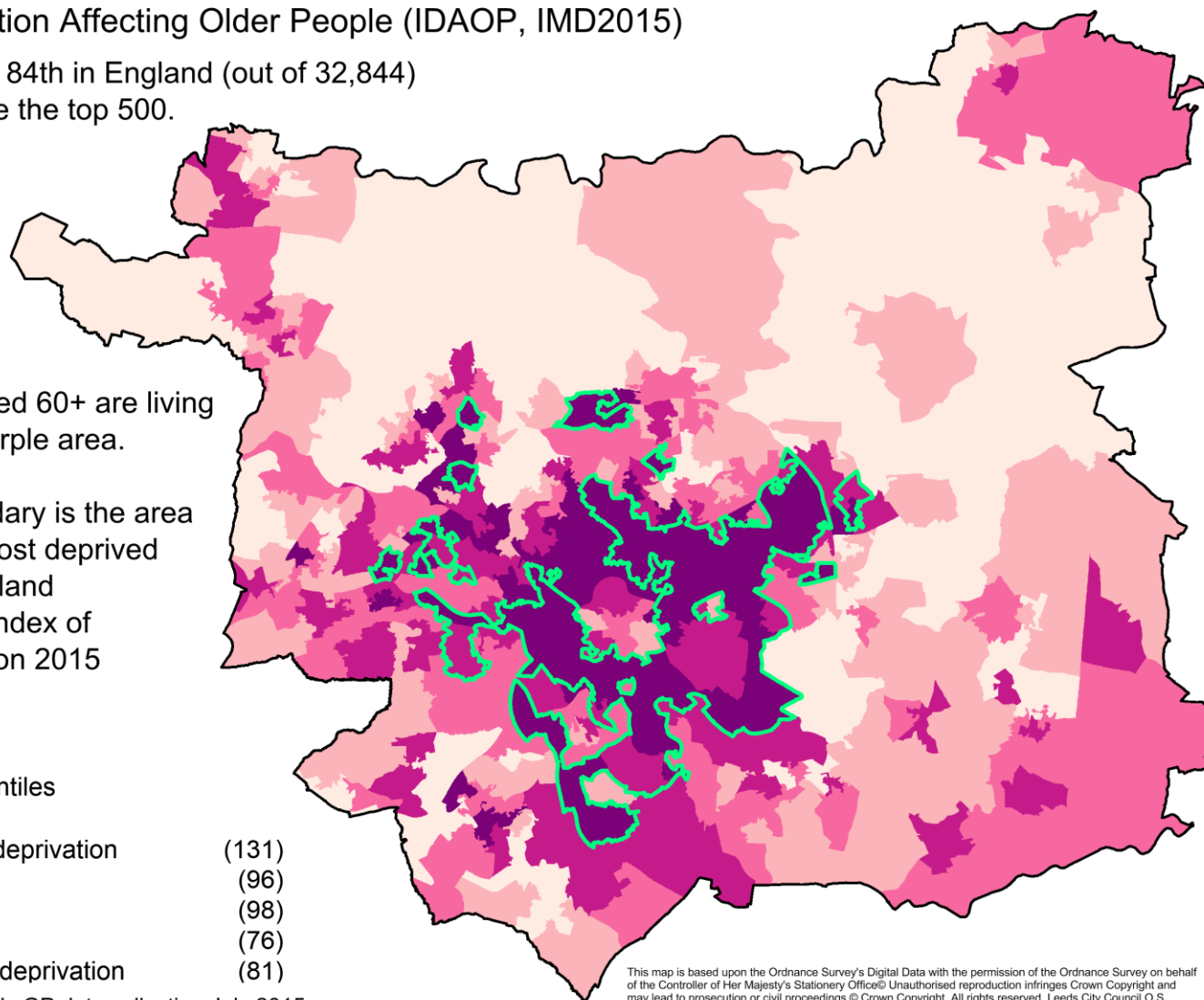
31,376 people aged 60+ are living inside the dark purple area.
