Appendix 2 Neighbourhood Network - Proposed uplift to put in place for October 2018 onwards

Table One provides the breakdown of the Neighbourhood Network areas and associated funding. It states the area references, core funding allocation as well as total allocation where further additional Leeds City Council Adults and Health funding has been secured. Finally it outlines the proposed funding for October 2018 onwards, along with a breakdown of the actual uplift value.

The uplift has been calculated by working out the percentage share each scheme has of the total funding, including add-ons (Column D). The percentage share has then been inverted so that those areas that currently receive the least investment from the contract and any additional funding to date see the greatest gains. An uplift equivalent to 8 x 2% year on year inflationary uplift on the core component of the funding has been calculated to establish a minimum an area should receive. This brings the proposed additional investment into the Neighbourhood Networks to £564,967pa.
