The current Third Sector Representative on the Health and Wellbeing Board has recently stood down. Following a nomination process and subsequent interview process undertaken by Forum Central, the body representing Third Sector health and social care organisations in Leeds, Alison Lowe – Chief Executive, Touchstone has been identified as the nomination to fill this vacancy. In addition to this, the representative of NHS (England) has recently retired and the proposal is for that vacancy to be filled by Anthony Kealy - Locality Director, NHS England North (Yorkshire & the Humber).
