Leeds Anti-Social Behaviour Team Review

Purpose of report

1. To provide an update to Community Committee's on progress made in reviewing the service currently provided by Leeds Anti-Social Behaviour Team.

Main issues

2. Consultation has highlighted that current levels of demand use are unsustainable and that an increasing number of individuals interacting with the service – both perpetrators and victims – have very complex needs and vulnerabilities:
 - Revise processes to ensure decision making is based on an effective triage system.
 - Embed the identification and assessment of risk in procedures from the first point of contact.
 - Extend and strengthen partnership working.
