New Application for Wellbeing Funding

Project title: Manor Farm Estate Replacement of Handrails
Name of group/organisation: Housing Leeds, Leeds City Council
Total project cost: £8,560
Amount proposed from budget 2021/22: £4,280 (Wellbeing)
Wards covered: Middleton Park

Project Description: Across the Manor Farm Estate are a number of communal steel handrails along the greenspaces and steps, which have, over time deteriorated and in parts have become unsafe. The proposal is to replace a number of these and in a couple of locations join these up where there are gaps.

Below is a list of the handrails:

- Manor Farm Way – 3 nos.
- Manor Farm Way to Manor Farm Gardens – replace 7 handrails.
- Manor Farm Gardens – 1 no opposite the Manor Farm Gardens road signage.
- Manor Farm Road – 1 no on step next to house number 36.
- Manor Farm Road – 1 no on step next to house number 14.
