Wellbeing Application: Cardio Cricket £1,000

This funding will secure the venue until October for the Cardio Cricket which aims to engage South Asian women in physical activity through fitness classes and cricket. The project has already made a positive impact in the Hyde Park/Burley area with over 50 South Asian women participating in the sessions.

YAF Application: Out There – Trans and Non-Binary Active £9,087

This pilot project will provide regular sport and activities in a safe social environment for transgender and non-binary children and young people aged 11-15. Upper age-range participants will be offered opportunities guidance and training to become assistants /team leaders towards developing this model.

Small Grants: INW CC Commissioned Project Fun in the park (HHP Group) £620

This funding will support a community event on Woodhouse Moor which has been planned by a group of community organisations (Wrangthorn Church, All Hallows, Left Bank, Hyde Park FC) in Hyde Park with the purpose of bringing people together of all ages and doing some informal consultation on the way ahead.

INW CC Commissioned Project Ireland Wood Summer Event & 2 Activity Days with Food £915

This funding will support a community event and also 2 activity days with food for local families in the school summer holidays. The aim to rebuild Ireland Wood Residents Association in order that it may function independently following the departure of all committee members.
