- 1. Project Title: Haslewood Drive Temporary CCTV Extension**
Name of Group or Organisation: LCC Leeds Watch

Funding will be used to allow for a three month extension of the temporary CCTV on Haslewood Drive in Burmantofts. The CCTV will be removed at the end of the project; and if incidents of ASB/ criminality has reduced this will be cited as a successful outcome. If incidents are continuing Leeds Watch will consider recommending a permanent CCTV provision.
