Title: Leeds Streets for All

Purpose of report

1. To provide the Outer North West Community Committee with a briefing about a consultation called the 'Leeds Streets for All' which enables people to have their say about issues related to travel in the community.

Main issues

2. The presentation is intended to provide the Outer North West Community Committee with an overview on how people can access public transport facilities, whether they feel unsafe walking, wheeling or cycling, the attractiveness of a street, or where traffic and speeding are causing issues.

The Connecting Leeds team are rolling the consultation out across Leeds by community committee area and it's currently live in the Inner North West and Outer North West areas until Sunday 7th April.

The main aim and key message is for people to have their say on transport/safety issues in their local area. Residents, businesses and stakeholders can do this by visiting a website and dropping a pin on a map.

The five main themes are:

- Vehicles and parking
- Walking and wheeling (including accessibility, prams, wheelchairs and scooters)
- Cycling
- Accessing bus stops and rail stations
- The street environment

The information provided to us will then help the Highways and Transport service prioritise improvements, as and when funding becomes available, in line with the Leeds Transport Strategy targets.
