1. Project Title: Summer Camp

Name of Group or Organisation: Horsforth Children's Services

Total Project Cost: £5,200.00 Amount proposed: £5,200.00 Wards covered: Horsforth

Project Description: The grant will be used to provide a week long summer camp for primary school aged children and will include sporting, artistic and other fun activities. In the first instance, the camp will be offered to vulnerable families, those who meet certain criteria such as being eligible for free school meals. We will also ask school staff to identify any families who may not meet those traditional criteria but whose children would benefit from the programme. We know that some children do not take part in any organised sessions over the long holidays, often due to the financial demands of activities, and this is detrimental to both physical and mental health. Our scheme will be free to those in the vulnerable groups. We hope to attract around 50 young people and have agreement from one of our local primary schools that we can use their facilities for free. As this is a targeted project, we are applying for wellbeing funding rather than YAF.

2. Project Title: Community Kitchen and Community meeting room development

Project Description: to install better catering facilities in the library and to develop the old staff room.

- Plaster both sides on the wall and line of the serving hatch in timber and fit 2 new doors to close the hatch off when not in use
- Cap off radiator
- Introduce cold water feed ready for new kitchen
- Fit new waste pipes
- Fit 2 new hot water tanks
- Fit new electrical extractor fan
- Supply new kitchen
