Proposed Community Governance Review of Ledston Parish Council

What is this report about?

Including how it contributes to the City's and council's ambitions

- Ledston Parish Council has requested that a Community Governance Review take place to consult publicly on the future of the Parish Council.
- The Council must consider this request and decide whether a Community Governance Review should take place.

Recommendations

- a) Members of General Purposes Committee take a decision on whether a Community Governance Review to consider the future of Ledston Parish Council should be undertaken.
- b) Should the decision be taken to undertake a Community Governance Review, to approve the terms of reference and timetable for the review (Appendix A).

Why is the proposal being put forward?

- On 1 November 2022, the Council received a request from the Chair of Ledston Parish Council for a Community Governance Review to be carried out to consider the future of the Parish (Appendix B).
- Ledston Parish Council sits within the Kippax and Methley Ward of Leeds City Council, polling districts KMD and KMI. A map can be found at Appendix C to this report.
- The electorate of the Parish is 287, represented by 5 Parish Councillors.
- As described in the request from the Chair of Ledston PC at Appendix B, the Parish Council has faced various difficulties over a period of approximately 7 years. These include poor governance, inability to attract and retain Councillors and a Parish Clerk, and an unsustainable financial position.
- In addition to the information provided by the Chair at Appendix B, the Council has also experienced several issues. More information on these can be found in the timeline of issues at Appendix D to this report.
- 6 Under the requirements of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act, the Council must now decide whether to proceed with a Community Governance Review.
- If the Committee decide the Council should undertake a review, this will commence on 15 December 2022.
- 8 Should the outcome of the review be to approve the abolition of the Parish, the intention is for this to occur prior to the publication of notice of election for the all-out Parish and Town Council Elections on 27 March 2023.
- As was the case at previous Community Governance Reviews, representations made during the consultation period outlined in Appendix A will be first be considered at the Councils Electoral Working Group (EWG) who are experienced in this role. EWG will make recommendations to General Purposes Committee for their consideration.
- If the Committee do not approve the undertaking of a review, the Parish Council may opt to reapply, and do so by petition signed by a designated percentage of the electorate, which would then automatically trigger a review to take place.
- Draft terms of reference for the review, if approved, are attached at Appendix A to this report, which includes a timetable for the review process.

- 15 The Council must consider whether to undertake a review in accordance with the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act.
- 16 Should a review take place, this will be conducted in accordance with the relevant regulations contained within the same Act.

What are the key risks and how are they being managed?

17 That the Parish Council continues to operate ineffectively, does not provide value for money to precept payers and is unable to deal with administrative procedures including the ability to field candidates at the parish council elections on 4 May 2023.
