How we are doing it

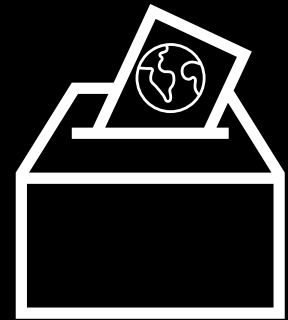
By showing how much voters care, we give you a powerful reason to act on the climate and the natural world.

What is a Commitment?

- Voters promise to vote only for the politicians who will take urgent action for the climate and natural world. We do not tell them how to vote.
- They explain why they are doing this (in words, images, video etc).



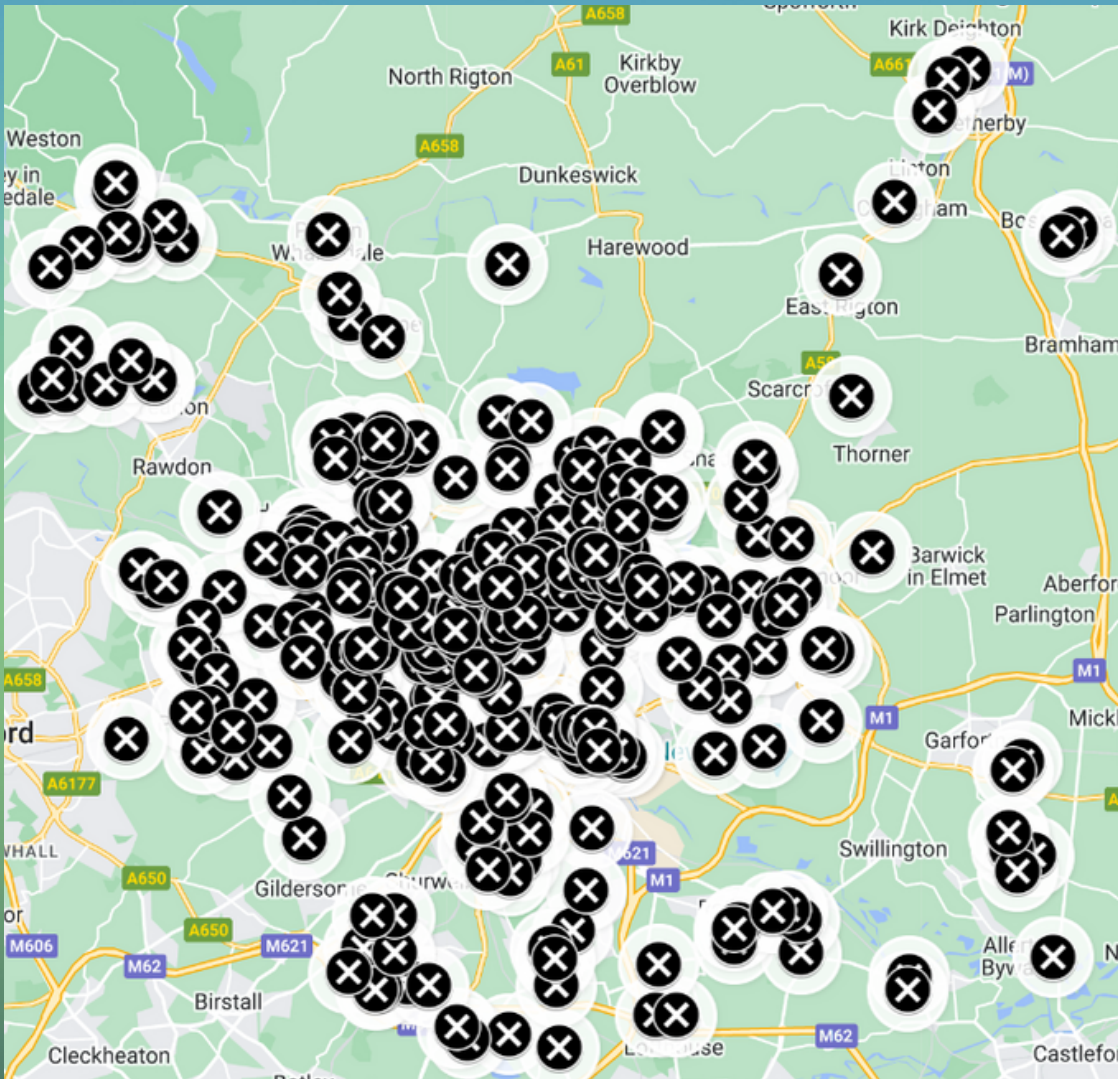
FAQs

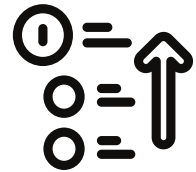
338

Climate change and the environment consistently rank in the top three policy concerns in surveys of the UK public. (IPPR, 2022)



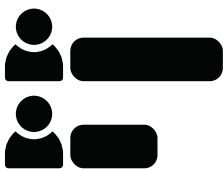

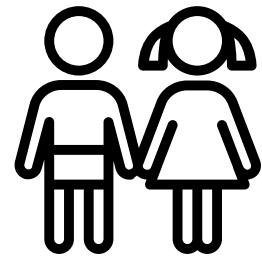

What they care about

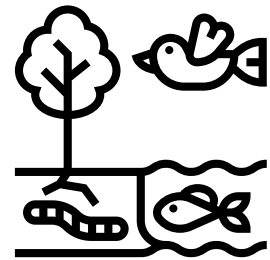
Future generations

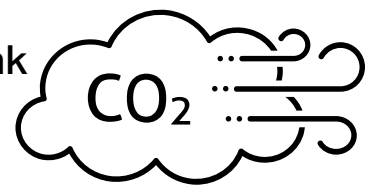
Protecting and restoring nature

In Leeds, many Committers wrote about the link between climate and public health, especially with regards to issues of air quality in urban environments.



What can you do?

Future Generations: Resilience to the risks and challenges of the climate emergency is crucial for the wellbeing of future generations. Will you recommend a timely target be set for the publication of the recently approved Climate Resilience and Adaptation Plan?

Nature: Will you support the development or refresh of an appropriate, cross departmental strategy for nature recovery and climate resilience as recommended by the UK Green Building Council in their 'Nature Recovery and Climate Resilience Playbook' for Local Authorities?

Health: Will you recommend that the need to reduce car use be integrated into the local plan? Friends of the Earth suggest that this include measures such as ensuring dense housing development with quality walking & cycling; restricted car parking provision; the provision of transport & delivery hubs to enable the use of cargo bikes and similar for deliveries; and support for climate adaptation measures such as green space and green architecture.

For non-partisan policy advice we can put you in touch with Green Alliance, the UK Health Alliance on Climate Change, the Nature Friendly Farming Network, Climate Emergency UK, and other experts.

I find it unbelievable that we have such a short amount of time left to bring climate change back under control and yet the most basic things like being able to recycle glass kerbside in Leeds still isn't possible, we still don't have a bottle return scheme which other countries have had for decades, our public transport system is still dire and we're continuing to take funding and instruction from fossil fuel giants. Something drastically needs to change and it needs to change quickly. |
