We strongly object to this small bar being given a premises licence to operate until the early hours due to the excessive noise, mess, and drinking outside on the highway directly under the residential flat known as [REDACTED].

The tenants pay their council taxes and expect a peaceful life without such disturbance and they have a Human right to expect this.

It should be noted that customers from the bar fill the highway drinking, smoking, loud shouting, [REDACTED]

This area is now fully residential with flats and bedrooms surrounding the highway known as Blayds Yard / Blayds Mews.

The external crowds drinking / smoking / gathering on the highway with loud music blaring from the bar until the early hours of the mornings are not acceptable and the Blays bar should not be given a premises License to inflict this on residential and business premises directly opposite the bars doorway.
