has suffered greatly in the form of petty vandalism, unauthorised access to our building noise and general antisocial behavior. My fear is that allowing licensed entertainment to take place on the residence doorstep will not only see an increase in such antisocial behavior but also potentially lead to unwanted noise for what could be up to 12 hours a day Please note that the residence is a listed building, which means that we as owners are severely limited in what we can do to combat loud noise

I realise that the applicants rational for the licensing application is to allow for the occasional event (approx 3 daytime events per annum) If this is the case I would ask that the applicant narrows the scope of the application to reflect such intentions
