Applications for Wellbeing Funding

1: Art Camp Half Terms & Christmas

Wards: Little London & Woodhouse, Headingley & Hyde Park

Located at Shire Oak Primary School in Headingley, Art Camp will take place in October Half Term, Christmas and February Half terms. The Art Camp provides a range of activities for children including circus skills, film making, drama, music. Art Camp will offer the 10 places to Children who have been deemed to be vulnerable and who would most benefit from three days each at our camps during the Oct/Dec/Feb half terms.

The October Half Term camp will be based on Halloween 'Spookily Spectacular' with pop singing, film making, TV presenting, Outdoor adventure, forest schools, bush craft, outdoor arts and crafts, circus skills, cookery, mini disco, dance, drama, music and DJing

The Christmas extravaganza, the children get to make Christmas themed art, Christmas carols, baking Christmas cookies, and Father Christmas attends with a gift for all the children.

In Feb TV presenting, Outdoor adventure, forest schools, bush craft, outdoor arts and crafts, circus skills, cookery, mini disco, dance, drama, music and DJing

Total Cost = £3,375 (£1,125 per camp)

2: Unorthobox

Ward: Weetwood

This application is to fund the purchase of 25 pairs of boxing gloves to assist the (non-profit) Unorthobox Group deliver non-contact mixed ability boxing sessions at Welcome Inn in Weetwood Ward to start in Early January 2022. This follows taster session delivered as part of the summer Healthy Holidays project delivered as a partnership between Opal and St Paul's Church in Ireland Wood. The sessions were extremely popular with local families especially their unique inclusivity of people of all abilities. The group will provide some further taster sessions as part of local Christmas events to generate interest in the January groups for both children and adults.

Total Cost = £500

3 Dress For Success

Wards: Little London & Woodhouse, Headingley & Hyde Park, Weetwood

This project will be run through the Leeds City Council Jobshop based in Merrion House. The project working intensively with individuals on a one to one basis to support their journey into sustainable employment has identified a number of barriers which includes having appropriate clothing footwear and or clothing for employment. This project will provide a voucher for a retailer in order to obtain the items. This project will run as a pilot for the Inner North West.

The project will support individuals to move into the world of work feeling confident wearing new, properly fitting workwear suitable for their new position. This enables them to move into work and

sustain employment, reducing their financial deprivation and making a positive contribution to our community.

Total Cost = £500

4 Commissioned Project: Dance Sessions at The Cardigan Community Centre

Wards: Little London & Woodhouse, Headingley & Hyde Park

This project has been commissioned following conversations with local families at the Healthy Holidays Projects during the summer in which they identified a need for local affordable dance sessions for children provided by a good instructor who can inspire.

This project will commission the Cardigan Community Centre to provide the local venue and Dominique the Dance tutor who provided the extremely popular taster sessions during the Healthy Holidays project delivered within the INW at Leeds Kirkgate market.

The project will be publicised through local schools and groups to ensure maximum participation.

Total Cost: £749

Total Cost of all Projects: £5,124
