3 Wellbeing Applications

Wellbeing Application: Little London Food Pantry £935.68

This funding will pay for the hire of Little London Community Centre for the full 2024/25 financial year. This will allow the pantry café, Zumba, Repair café, Health Checks, Uniform Exchange to continue to take place alongside the food pantry every Friday.

Wellbeing Application: LS6 Library of Things £2,700

This funding will pay for a professional company to transform their digital presence which will bring in more members on a pay as you feel basis and also offer the opportunity to donate online which will increase their financial sustainability.

Wellbeing Application: Irish Arts £1,550

This funding will pay for the delivery of interactive workshops and activities which promote Irish Culture and music.

Total: £5,185.68

4 Youth Activities Fund Applications

LCC Youth Service: Standing Proud £ 3,500

This funding would pay the costs for running this group in the Hyde Park/Burley area based in the Cardigan Community Centre for 2024/25 for one weekly session x 50 weeks.

LCC Youth Service: Weetwood Youth Activities £ 5,180

This funding would pay the costs for running 2 weekly groups in Weetwood based in the Welcome In x 50 weeks.

LCC Youth Service: Holiday Projects Across INW £ 2,960

This funding would pay for diversionary activities aimed at vulnerable young people in the school holidays

Leeds United Foundation: Community Football Drop -In Ireland Wood £5,000

This funding would pay for weekly community drop-in football sessions 1 x 8-12 years, and 1x 13-17 years for 50 weeks per year. This does not include any venue hire which may be required in Winter.
