It was made clear by the residents who attended that one of the main issues was concern any noise emanating from the building late at night.

One of the concerns is the use of the external areas where noise would possibly disturb residents sleeping, especially children and those who had to go to work or school in the morning. This also appears to be one of the main concerns from the written objections too.

I cannot remember any agreement being asked for regarding times of opening other than the centre explaining why they feel they wanted the times they have asked for and also telling people what the police has suggested.

I know the licensing panel using the experience of its members will come to a measured conclusion.
