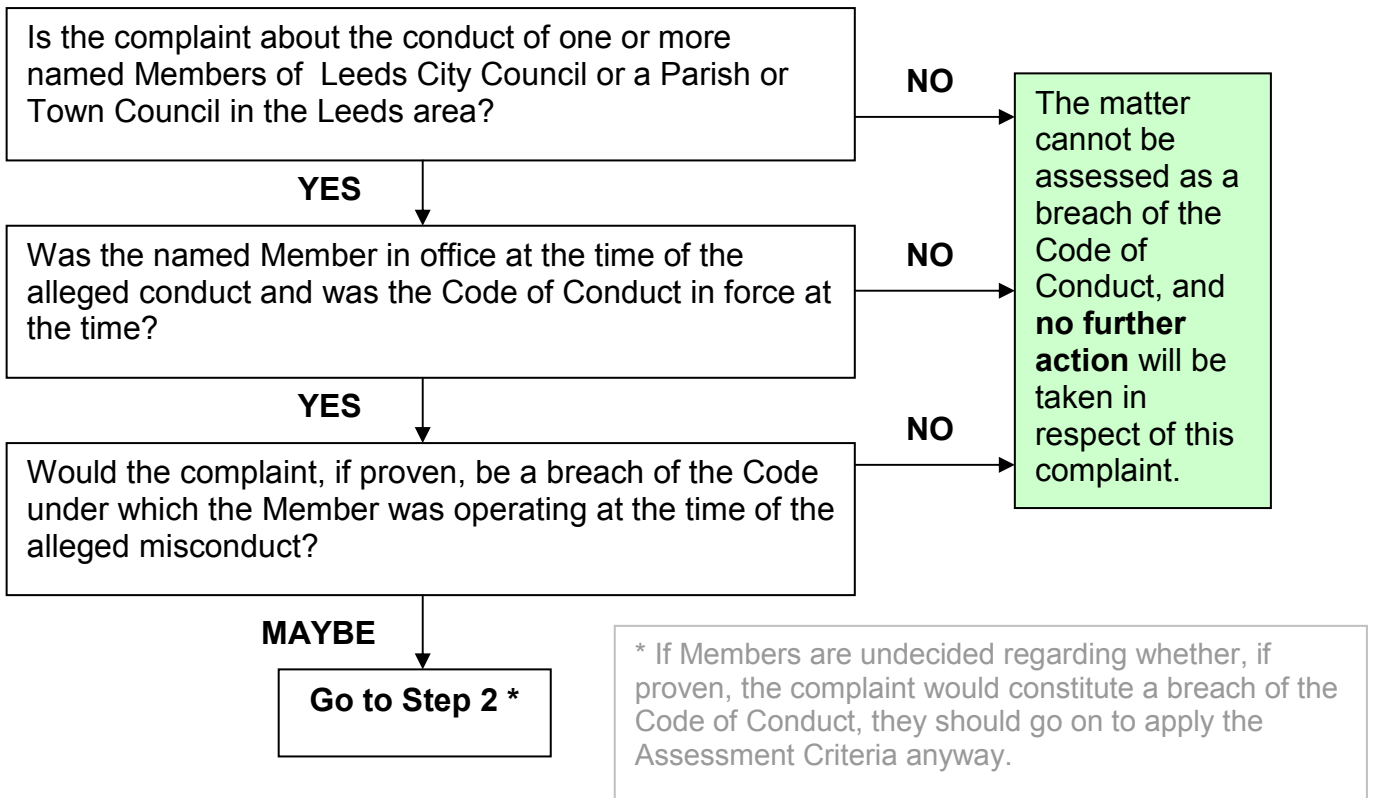

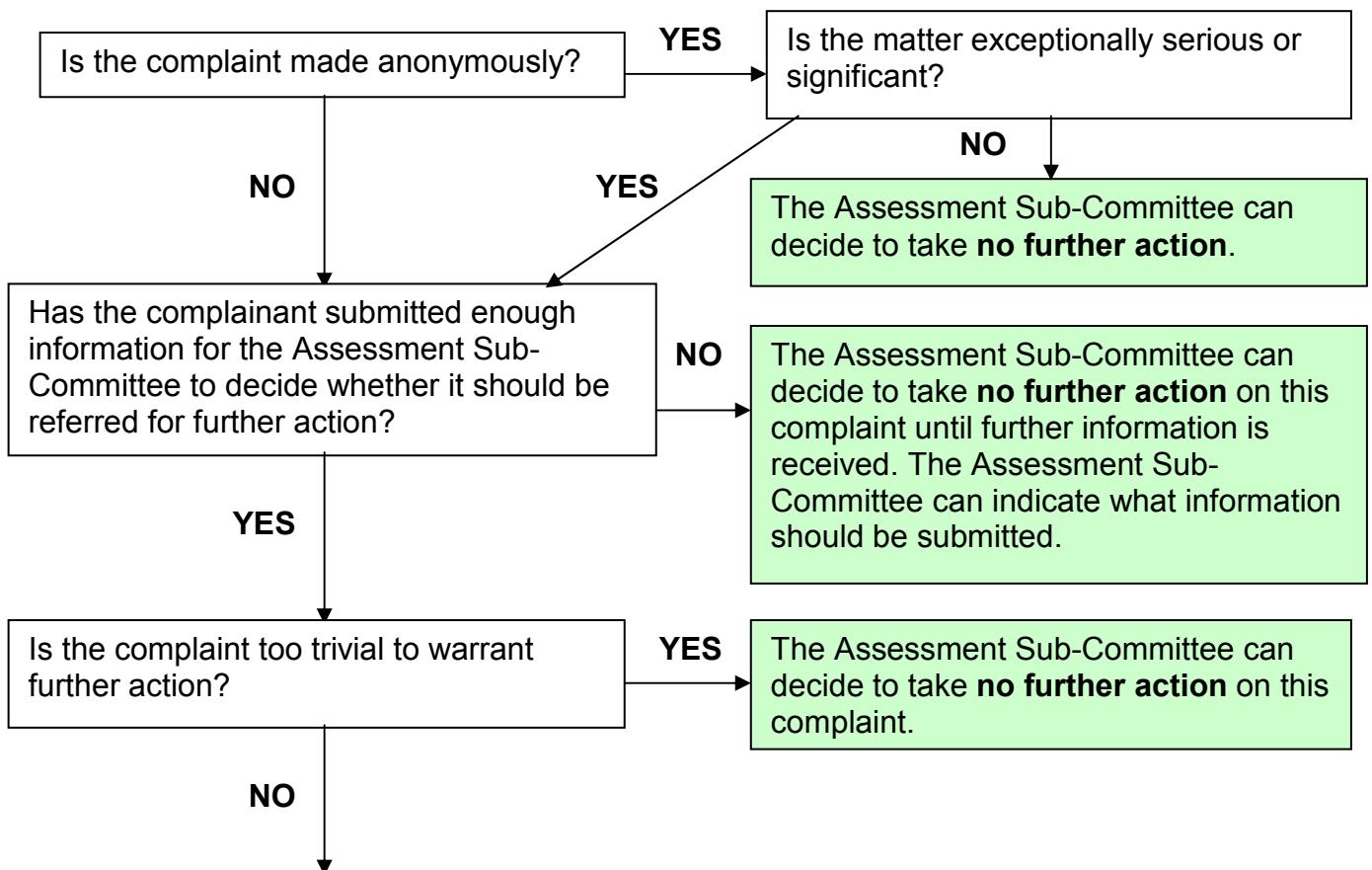

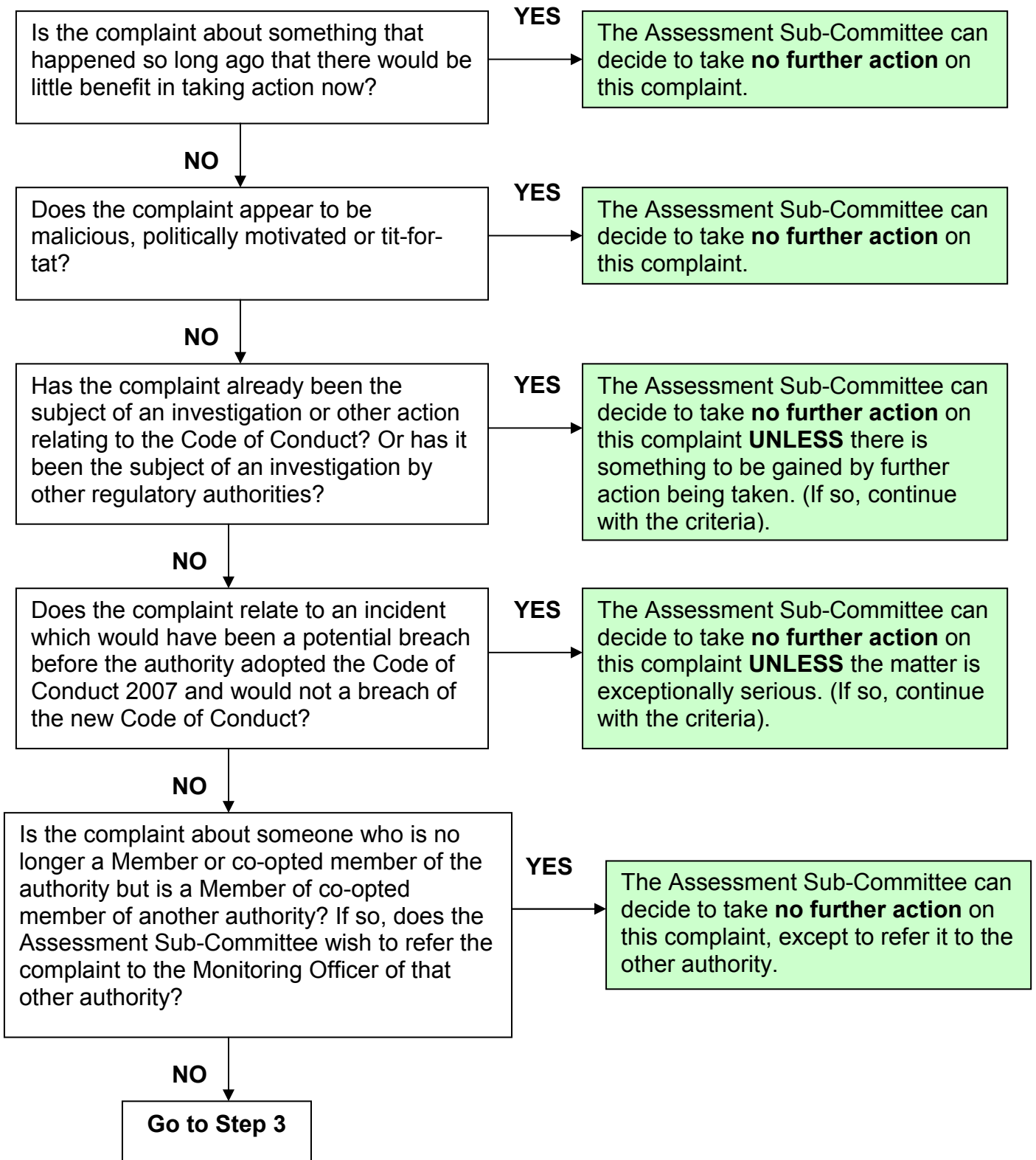
Assessment Flowchart

Step 1 - Initial Tests

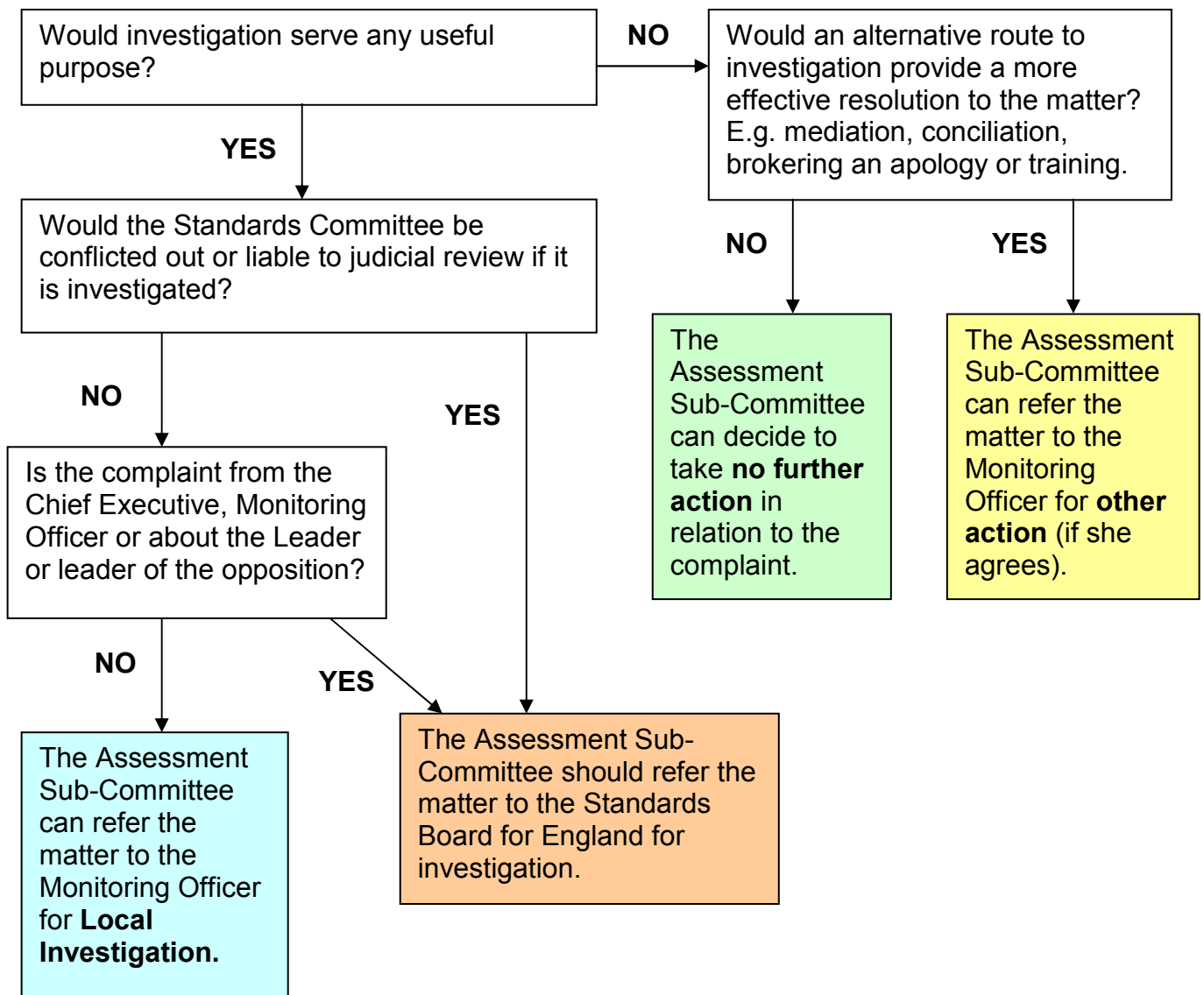


Step 2 – Applying Assessment Criteria
