#### Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence
  - a. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

#### Embedded restrictions attached to the licence by virtue of grandfather rights.

3. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.

In this condition, permitted hours means:

- a. On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- b. On Sundays, other than Christmas Day, 10 a.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- c. On Christmas Day, 12 noon to 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- 4. The above restrictions do not prohibit:
  - a. the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
  - b. the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- 5. Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises.

#### Conditions consistent with the operating schedule relating to the licensing objectives

#### General – All four licensing objectives

- 7. The Society has in place policies for the regular training of its employees to prevent the sale of alcohol to those under the age of 18 years.
- 8. The Society will maintain at each store a refusals register.
- 9. The Society actively supports the use of photo identity cards and will use the Portman Group Card where local authority schemes are not available or suitable.
- 10. The Society's policy requires its employees actively to challenge any individual who wishes to purchase alcohol at one of its stores but appears to be under 21 years of age to prove their age by means of photo identity card.

#### The prevention of crime and disorder

- 11. The Society will work to achieve and maintain regular liaison with the police at an appropriate regional and or local level and will make available to the police any CCTV recorded images and the stores refusals book.
- 12. The Society will regularly provide appropriate training to all of its relevant employees in connection with the sale of alcohol and will augment this with immediate remedial retraining if it becomes apparent that an employee requires it.

#### The prevention of public nuisance

13. The Society will endeavour to ensure that any noise and light pollution from the premises is not overly obtrusive in the context of the stores location.

#### The protection of children from harm

14. The Society has in place policies for the regular training of its employees to prevent the sale of alcohol to those under the age of 18 years.

#### General

The applicant has given thought to the potential impact of the grant of this application on the four licensing objectives and considers that the following conditions are appropriate.

#### The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

- The premises shall maintain a CCTV system which gives coverage of all entry and exit points. The system shall continually record whilst the premises are open and conducting licensable activities. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 21 days. Recordings shall be made available upon the receipt of a request by an authorised Officer of the Police or the Local Authority.
- 2. There shall be "CCTV in Operation" signs prominently displayed at the premises.
- An incident log (whether kept in a written or electronic form) shall be retained at the premises and made available to an authorised Officer of the Police or the Local Authority.
- 4. The premises shall operate a proof of age scheme, such as a Challenge 25, whereby the only forms of acceptable identification shall be either a photographic driving licence, a valid passport or any other recognised form of photographic identification-incorporating the PASS logo.
- 5. The premises will be fitted with a burglar alarm system
- 6. The premises will be fitted with a panic button system for staff to utilise in the case of an emergency.

#### **Public Safety**

The premises licence holder shall ensure that the appropriate fire safety, and health and safety regulations are applied at the premises.

#### Prevention of Public Nuisance

The premises licence holder will, upon request, provide the telephone number of their Customer Relations Contact Centre.

#### **Protection of Children from Harm**

- All staff will receive comprehensive training in relation to age restricted products and in particular the sale of alcohol. No member of staff will be permitted to sell age restricted products until such time as they have successfully completed the aforementioned training.
- An age till prompt system will be utilised at the premises in respect of age restricted products.
- A refusals register (whether kept and written or electronic form) will be maintained at the premises and will be made available for inspection upon request by an authorised Officer of the Police or the Local Authority.

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
