Summary of main issues

This is an application for the grant of a premises licence, made by Mr Arshid Iqbal, for The Bulls Head 20 St Matthews Street, Holbeck, Leeds, LS11 9NR

The application is for Live music, recorded music, sale by retail of alcohol as noted in 3.3.

Responsible authorities and Ward Members have been notified of this application.

The application has attracted representation from responsible authorities and other persons.

1.0 Purpose of this Report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") for a premises licence in respect of the above mentioned premises.
- 1.2 Members are required to consider this application due to the receipt of representations.

2.0 History of Premises

- 2.1 This is the first application for a premises licence applied for by Mr Iqbal.

2.2 The premises previously had the benefit of a premises licence for the following licensable activities:-

Sale by retail of alcohol, live music, recorded music

Mon – Sat 10:00 – 00:00

Sun 12:00 – 22:30

This was surrendered by the licence holder on the 10th May 2013. During the 28 day consultation period no transfer application was received therefore the licence lapsed.

3.0 The Application

3.1 The applicant is Mr Arshid Iqbal,

3.2 The application form may be found at Appendix A to this report.

3.3 In summary the application is for

Sale by retail of alcohol, live music and recorded music

Sunday – Thursday 11:00 – 23:00

Friday and Saturday 11:00 – 00:00

4.0 Other matters relevant to the application

4.1 At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the Licensing Sub-Committee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.

5.0 Steps to promote the Licensing Objectives

5.1 The applicant proposes to take specific steps to promote the licensing objectives identified in the Pro-forma Risk Assessment; a copy of which may be found at Appendix A.

6.0 Proposed Designated Premises Supervisor

6.1 Kelly Storm Shaw intends to be the Designated Premises Supervisor.

7.0 Location

7.1 A map which identifies the location of this premise is attached at Appendix B.

8.0 Representations

8.1 Under the Act representations can be received from responsible authorities or other persons. Representations must be relevant and, in the case of another person, must not be frivolous or vexatious.

8.2 Representations from Responsible Authorities

8.2.1 Representations have been received from West Yorkshire Police, Health and Safety service and EPT team in their capacity as a responsible authority.

8.2.2 Any representations submitted may be agreed prior to a hearing. In this instance the operating schedule has been amended to include measures agreed with West Yorkshire Police, Health & Safety and EPT Team. A copy of the agreed measures may be found at Appendix C.

8.3 Other representations

8.4 The application has attracted representations from other persons.

8.4.1 The licensing section is in receipt of one letter of objection which is opposed to this application on the grounds of noise nuisance.

8.4.2 A copy of the representation will be available at the hearing for Members consideration.

9.0 Options Available to Members

9.1 The licensing sub-committee must take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- Grant the application as requested.
- Grant the application whilst imposing additional conditions and/or altering in any way the proposed operating schedule.
- Exclude any licensable activities to which the application relates.
- Refuse to specify the said person as the designated premises supervisor.
- Reject the whole or part of the application.

9.2 Members of the licensing sub committee are asked to note that they may not modify the conditions or reject the whole or part of the application merely because it considers it desirable to do so. It must actually be appropriate in order to promote the licensing objectives.
