Dear Sir or Madam

We refer to the licence application for the above premises and write to officially register our objection.

Operating until 3am is completely unsuitable for the area with many residences nearby. The hours are in excess of any other licensed premises in the area and are more akin to that of a night club. If granted, the late opening will cause noise disturbance to surrounding homes and put people on the streets of Chapel Allerton at a far later hour, increasing the opportunity for public nuisance and disorder.

We would like to think that an area with a Cumulative Impact Policy in place would not have premises which serve alcohol operating until the early hours of the morning. We strongly object to the requested hours and trust that our comments will be taken into account when considering this application.
