#### Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence
  - a. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

#### The prevention of crime and disorder

4. Proof of age

The Licensee will adopt a proof of age scheme which is approved by WYP and West Yorkshire Trading Standards (WYTS)

5. The licensee's staff will ask for proof of age from any person appearing to be under the age of 21 who attempts to purchase alcohol at the premises.

#### **Public safety**

6. Electrical installations will be inspected on a periodic basis (at least every 5 years) by a suitably qualified and competent person. Inspection records/certificates will be kept. These will be made available at the request of an authorised officer.

#### The prevention of public nuisance

7. The licensee will ensure that business waste is stored inside closed containers awaiting collection, that litter arising from people using the premises is cleared away regularly, that promotional materials such as flyers do not create litter, and that other street advertising is carried out lawfully.

### The protection of children from harm

8. Signs will be provided informing customers that sales will not be made to under 18s, and that age identification may be required.
