The premises have recently come to the attention of West Yorkshire Police via an application to extend the licensable activities. Upon receipt of the application checks were carried out with various agencies to ensure that there were no issues which had not been highlighted previously.

Information was received from HM Revenue & Customs investigators that there had been seizures made from these premises over the last 3 consecutive years, of counterfeit products and goods which had not had UK duty paid.

The Premises Licence Holder, Mr Mohammed Noori, is also a Premises Licence Holder for an off licence at 14 Eldon Terrace. Within the statement received from HM Revenue & Customs, those premises are also shown to have a number of seizures, again over the last 3 consecutive years, for products which are either counterfeit or have not had the UK duty paid. An application for review has also been submitted for the Premises Licence relating to this address.

Evidence shows there is a persistent and clear intention by the Premises Licence Holder to trade fraudulently at the premises, which undermines the Crime and Disorder licensing objective. These activities cannot be allowed to continue.

Counterfeit products with unclear manufacturing provenance are at risk of causing serious harm to the health of the general public; most consumers are not even aware that the items which have been sold to them are not genuine products; the bona fide varieties of which have undergone the appropriate testing procedures. It has been documented that counterfeit tobacco contains higher levels of nicotine and produce more carbon monoxide. They could also incorporate a seriously unhealthy mix of cancer-causing chemicals including arsenic, cadmium, benzene and formaldehyde – far greater than genuine cigarettes. It has also been

documented that illicit alcohol has been known to contain chemicals used in antifreeze within their manufacture, and can cause health issues ranging from nausea to blindness or even coma and death.

These premises are situated in a densely populated student area. The operators are exploiting the students' financial circumstances by selling the cheaper but unsafe products knowing that the customer base will want to buy them rather than question the origin of the cheaper items.

Duty evasion is a serious issue and undermines the UK's financial stability; on average the economy loses $\pounds 2.2$ billion from tobacco and $\pounds 1.2$ billion from alcohol per year. The penalties imposed for duty evasion can be an unlimited fine and/or up to 7 years imprisonment. In relation to the counterfeit products, there are unlimited financial penalties and /or up to 10 years imprisonment.

West Yorkshire Police support HM Revenue & Customs in jointly taking action in respect to these serious offences and upholding the licensing objectives.
