 - b. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

The prevention of crime and disorder

- 5. A suitable CCTV system will be maintained and be operational on the premises.
- 6. A Designated Premises Supervisor will be on site.
- 7. Adopt the Check 21 proof of age scheme in accordance with guidance issued by WYP
- 8. All refusals of sales of alcohol will be recorded in the refusals register. The Register will contain the following details:-

The time, day and date the refusal was made.

The name and address of the staff member refusing the sale.

The name and address of the person attempting to buy the alcohol (where supplied)

Full description of said person and full details of the alcohol they attempted To purchase.

- The refusals register must be produced upon request of the Police or a relevant officer of a responsible authority.
- 10. All sales staff responsible for making sales to members of the public will undergo relevant and appropriate training with regards to Check 21 and refusals register
- 11. A training register will be maintained at the premises. The register will contain training records which include the following:-

The time, day and date the training was given.

The signature of the person supplying and the person receiving said training.

The training register must be produced upon request to the police or a relevant officer of a Responsible Authority.

12. All sales for consumption off the premises will only be in sealed containers.

Public safety

- 13. Fire fighting systems will be in place.
- 14. Fire detection systems will be in place.
- 15. All exit doors will be accessible, easy opening.

The prevention of public nuisance

- 16. Ensure that no nuisance is caused by vibration emanating from the premises.
- 17. Ensure that noise from plant or machinery is inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive premises during the operation of the plant or machinery. Plant or machinery shall be regularly serviced and maintained to continue to meet this level.
- 18. Clear and legible notices shall be displayed at exits and other circulatory areas requesting patrons to leave the premises having regard to the needs of local residents, in particular emphasising the need to refrain from shouting, slamming car doors sounding horns and loud use of vehicle stereos and anti social behaviour. The activity of persons leaving the premises shall be monitored and they shall be reminded to leave quietly where necessary
- 19. Display of notices to reduce litter.
- 20. Provision of litter bins outside the premises.

The protection of children from harm

- 21. Signs will be provided informing customers that sales of alcohol will be not be made to under 18s and that age identification may be required.
- 22. Will ask for proof of age from anyone appearing under 18 who is attempting to purchase alcohol
