**In paragraph 2, delete after “in cycling infrastructure is” and replace with:**

‘important if cycling is to continue to grow in Leeds.’

**Delete all after “investment in cycling in Leeds” in paragraph 3 and replace with:**

‘whenever budgets allow and to continue to bid for national funding pots, such as the recent Leeds Cycle City bid, to boost cycling infrastructure in the city.’

This Council is mindful of the budget pressures currently facing local authorities and would seek to balance investment in cycling infrastructure against other priorities such as funding for older people’s care services, continued investment in protecting and supporting the city’s young people and children, investing in growth and employment opportunities for Leeds residents and improving the Council’s housing stock.’

**Motion will read:**

Council believes that the interest generated by hosting the Grand Depart of next year's Tour de France represents a once in a lifetime opportunity to increase the number of active cyclists in Leeds and recognises that sustained investment in cycling infrastructure is important if cycling is to continue to grow in Leeds.

Given the many benefits that cycling can bring, Council commits to the principle of increasing investment in cycling in Leeds whenever budgets allow and to continue to bid for national funding pots, such as the recent Leeds Cycle City bid, to boost cycling infrastructure in the city.

This Council is mindful of the budget pressures currently facing local authorities and would seek to balance investment in cycling infrastructure against other priorities such as funding for older people’s care services, continued investment in protecting and supporting the city’s young people and children, investing in growth and employment opportunities for Leeds residents and improving the Council’s housing stock.
