Summary of main issues

The application is for the sale of alcohol – Off sales only - and the provision of Late Night Refreshment as noted in 3.3

1.0 Purpose of this Report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") for a premises licence in respect of the above mentioned premises.

2.0 History of Premises

2.1 This is the first application for a Premises Licence for these premises.

3.0 The Application

- 3.1 The applicant is Shell UK Oil Products Ltd,

- 3.3 In summary the application is for :-

The Sale of Alcohol – for consumption Off the Premises

Every Day - 00:00 to 24:00

The Provision of Late Night Refreshment

Every Day – 23:00 to 05:00

Opening Hours of the Premises

Every Day 00:00 to 24:00

4.0 Other matters relevant to the application

4.1 At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the Licensing Sub-Committee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.

5.0 Steps to promote the Licensing Objectives

5.1 The applicant intends to take specific steps as submitted with the application - attached as Appendix C – in order to promote the four licensing objectives.

6.0 Proposed Designated Premises Supervisor

6.1 Mr Robert Gwyn Griffith intends to be the Designated Premises Supervisor.

7.0 Location

7.1 A map which identifies the location of this premise is attached at Appendix B.

8.0 Representations

- 8.1 Under the Act representations can be received from responsible authorities or other persons. Representations must be relevant and, in the case of another person, must not be frivolous or vexatious.
- 8.2 Representations from Responsible Authorities
- 8.2.1 There have been no representations from responsible authorities.
- 8.3 Other representations
- 8.3.1 The application has attracted representations from other persons.
- 8.3.2 The Licensing Section is in receipt of three public objections together with one from Horsforth Parish Council.
- 8.3.3 The grounds for the objection relate to concern over health issues, noise nuisance, the hours of operation and crime and disorder
- 8.3.4 Copies of the representations will be available at the hearing for Members consideration.

9.0 Options Available to Members

- 9.1 The licensing sub-committee must take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:
 - Grant the application as requested.
 - Grant the application whilst imposing additional conditions and/or altering in any way the proposed operating schedule.
 - Exclude any licensable activities to which the application relates.
 - Refuse to specify the said person as the designated premises supervisor.
 - Reject the whole or part of the application.
- 9.2 Members of the licensing sub committee are asked to note that they may not modify the conditions or reject the whole or part of the application merely because it considers it desirable to do so. It must actually be appropriate in order to promote the licensing objectives.
