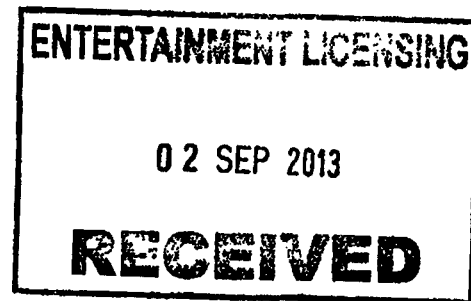

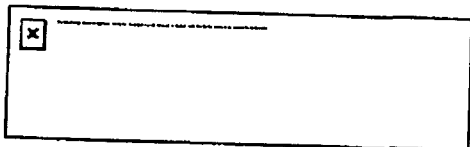

POLICE – LETTER OF REPRESENTATION – ‘QUALIFIED’ OBJECTION:

Thank you for submitting your application for the above premises, this application was received at the address above on 8 August 2013. The electronic submission was received by Leeds City Council on 5 August 2013 but due to difficulties with the electronic document a faxed copy was not received in this office until three days later. The original deadline was set for the 2 September 2013, but problems with the advertising process have seen the deadline move to 9 September 2013.

The application was submitted in the name of Mexi Khana Halal Ltd with a company number of 86211381. It is worth pointing out at this stage that the correct company number for this limited company is 08621381. This error was pointed out at a meeting on 29 August 2013. Obtaining the correct applicant details is an important part of the application process. This letter of representation refers to the correctly numbered company and has been confirmed with Leeds City Council Licensing.

West Yorkshire Police are of the opinion that your application contains insufficient information about how you intend to meet the licensing objectives.

We therefore confirm that we are submitting a formal representation against your application on the grounds of:-

1. the prevention of crime & disorder
2. the prevention of public nuisance, and
3. the protection of children from harm.

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However, West Yorkshire Police are also of the opinion that the said objectives could be met should you be prepared to incorporate certain identified measures within your operating schedule, in addition to those you may have offered in your application.

Please find enclosed a document which at **Part 1** contains the suggested measures which this authority considers are proportionate and appropriate to the nature of your application.

Should you be in agreement with the suggested measures then please signify this by completing and signing **Part 2** of the enclosed form and return the complete document to this office as soon as possible. Upon receipt of your consent at **Part 2**, it will be taken that you signify your wishes for the licensing authority to amend your operating schedule to incorporate the proposed measures.

Alternatively should you disagree with the proposed measures, then please complete **Part 3** and again return the complete document to this office as soon as possible.

Friday and Saturday - 1100hrs x 0230hrs
Sunday 1100hrs x 2330hrs

The times for alcohol sales were reduced by half an hour by submitting an additional page of the application.

Having considered the application under the Licensing Act 2003 for the above premises, West Yorkshire Police considers that the following measures are relevant, proportionate and necessary in order to promote the following licensing objectives:-

- the prevention of crime & disorder
- the prevention of public nuisance
- the protection of children from harm

On 29 August 2013 a meeting took place at Stainbeck Police Station in which the application was discussed and the management structure and style of operation were outlined.

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Mexi Khana Halal Ltd is a reincarnation of Bar Noir Ltd, which operated from the same premises. The management structure will be the same but the style of operation, we are told, will change. The premises intend to be food lead with a restaurant menu during the day and a snack menu to accompany drinks later in the evening.

The premises will also operate a membership scheme after 2100hrs on Friday and Saturday evenings and entry will only be gained to the venue after this process has been completed. The operators hope that this will ensure minimum levels of crime and disorder and early detection of offences.

All of these points were discussed on the 29th and the addition measure below will add clarity to any licence produced. These measures are in addition to conditions already offered by the applicant.

- **Measures / Additional measures proposed:**
- **The CCTV footage will be controlled and kept in a secure environment to prevent tampering or unauthorised viewing. A record will be kept of who has accessed the system, the reason why and when.**
- **Until 2100hrs each day the premises licence has effect a minimum of 60 covers will be provided for alcohol to be consumed on the premises only with a table meal.**
- **Between 2100hrs and 2400hrs each day the premises licence has effect a minimum of 40 covers will be provided for alcohol to be consumed on the premises only with a table meal.**
- **No children on the premises after 2100hrs each day when the premises licence has effect.**
- **The minimum number of door supervisors for the premises will be 2 on Friday and Saturday nights. Door staff will be on duty from 2100hrs until one hour after close of business.**

West Yorkshire Police are satisfied that the proposed measures are not adequately dealt with by other legislation.

By signing the declaration enclosed overleaf at **Part 2**, the applicant agrees to incorporate the proposed measures within the Operating Schedule for the said premises.

Upon the satisfactory completion of the declaration, West Yorkshire Police will provide notice to the Licensing Authority that our representation is withdrawn in accordance with schedule 10(a) of the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005.
