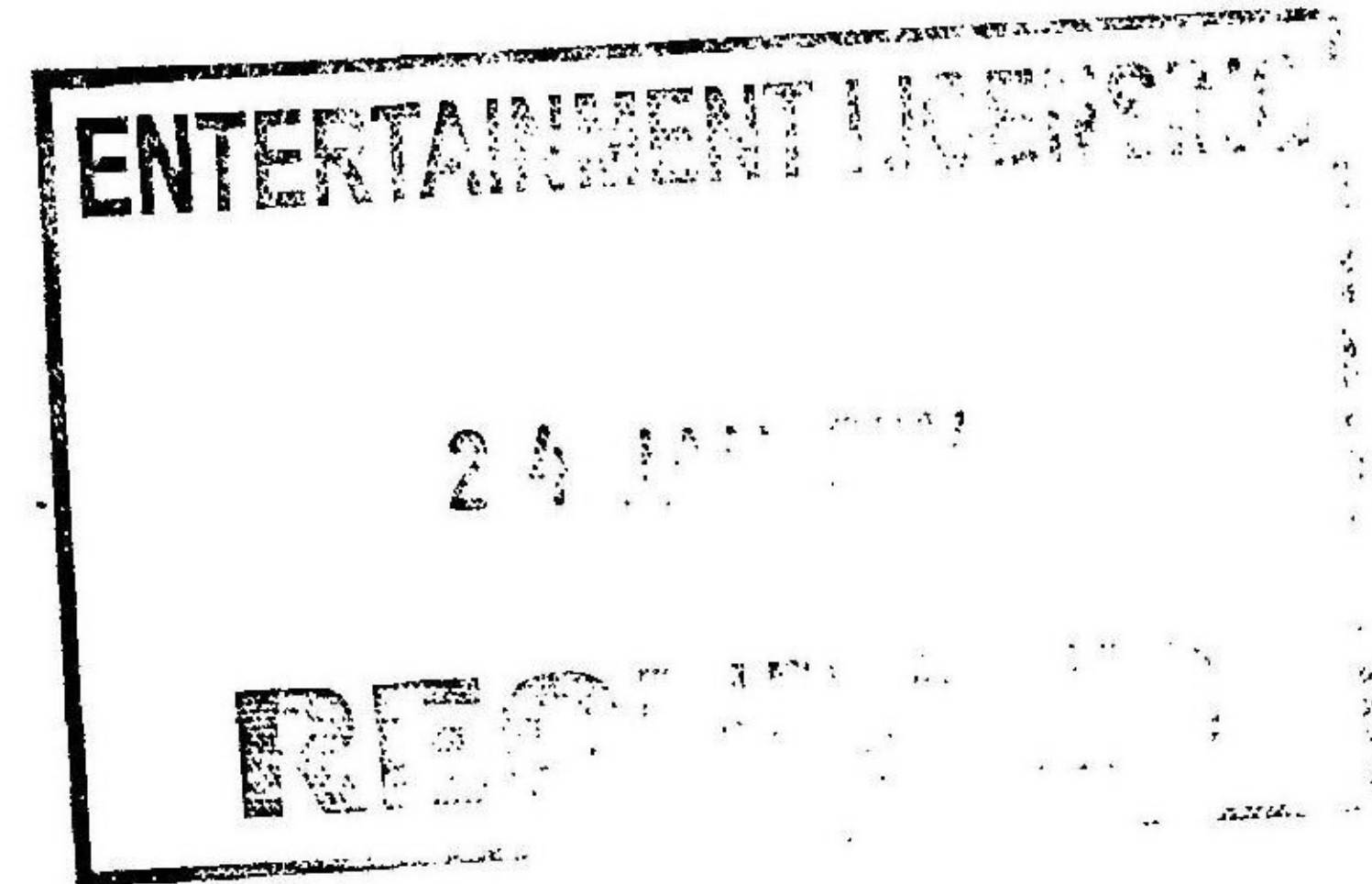
Good evening,

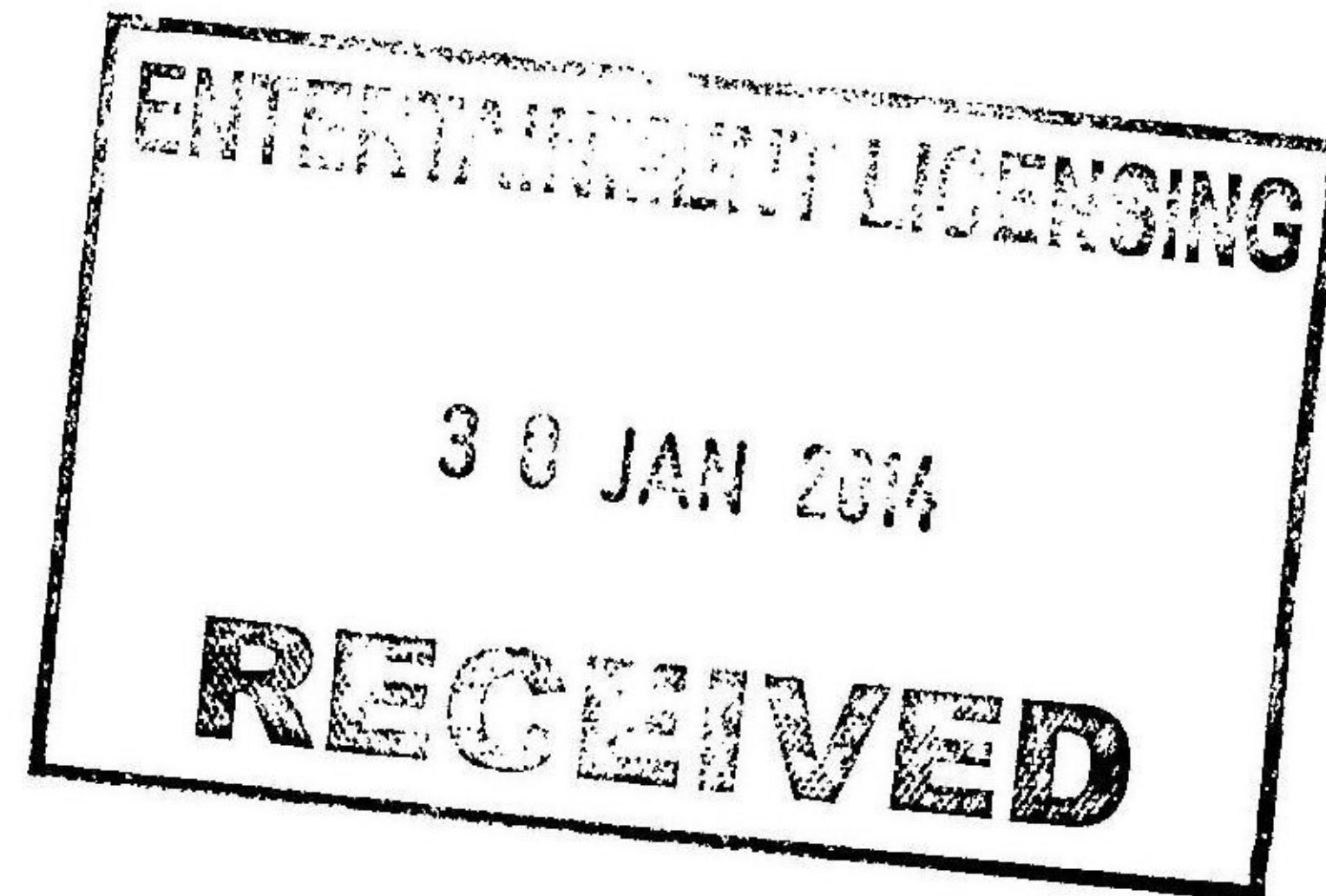

I am writing in response to a letter regarding the application for an extension of the Grove Hill Club licensing and music hours.

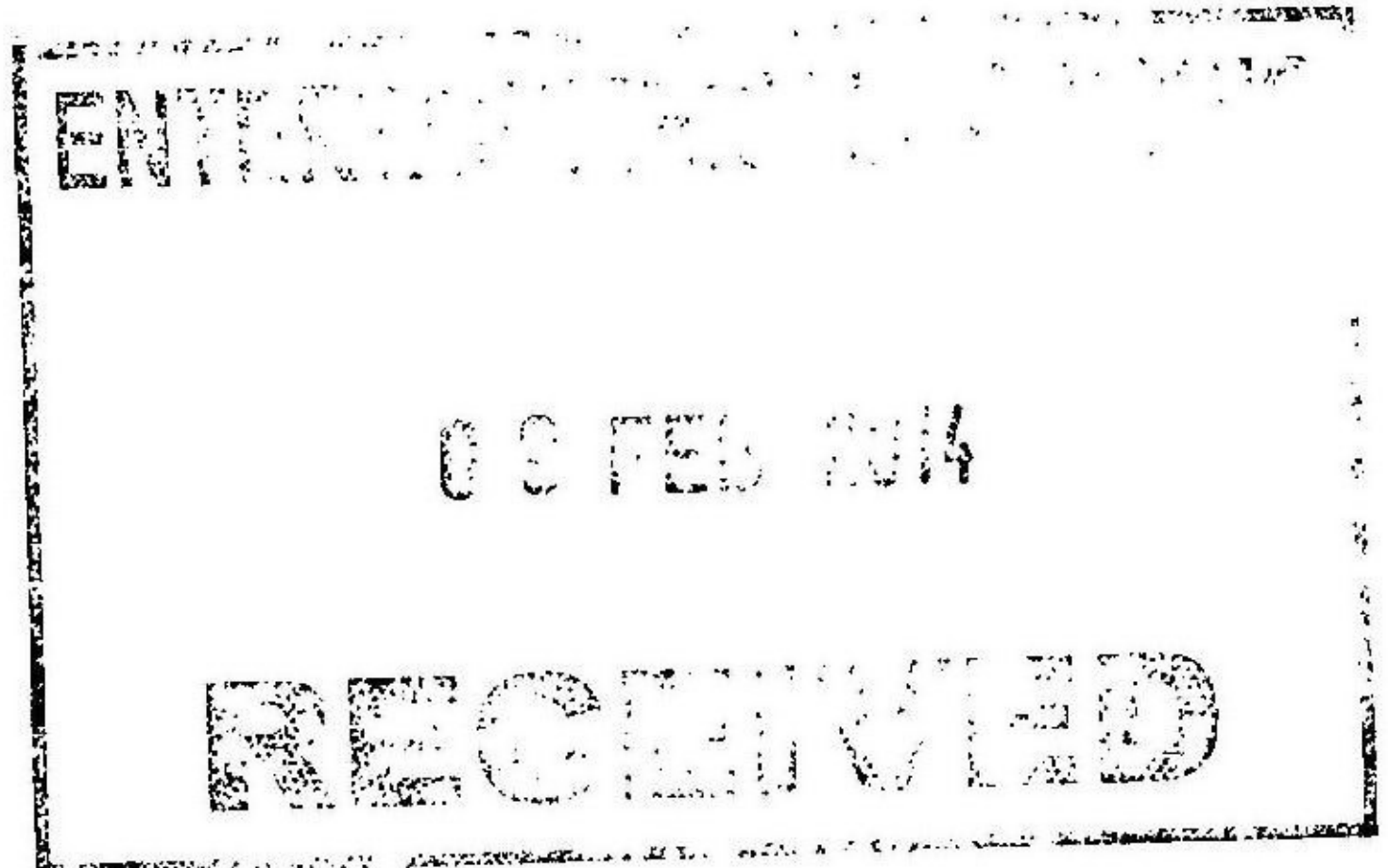
I would like to raise my objection to this. My family and I live directly opposite the club and at times the music and noise from conversations are very loud. The smoking area being directly opposite our house contributes to this, but particularly on summer evenings when more people are standing outside the noise is too loud.

Additionally the conversations often use language that I do not want to hear and I especially do not want my two young children to hear.

My husband and I, as parents with young children, chose to live in a residential area and not the centre of a town for the obvious reasons, and therefore we are concerned that if the licensing hours are approved then our area will cease to feel like a family residential road.
