ACTION

- 1. Introductions and Apologies**
Apologies were received from Councillors Dunn and Gettings and Keith Hewitt of City Services.
- 2. Matters arising and minutes of the last meeting**
Minutes of the last meeting were agreed as an accurate record.
- 3. Update on community facilities in Outer South Leeds**
A full update was provided on current issues at each facility and the progress that is being made – an update on each building is incorporated into the action plan.
- 4. South Leeds Community Centres Pricings and Lettings Policy**
The report which is being presented at July's Area Committee meeting was discussed. Comments were made with regards to the increase of some charges, particularly those at Morley Town Hall. TPO stated that dependant on the comments received during the consultation period, these prices may be revised before the new charging rates are introduced on October 1st. SM also explained that there is also a schedule of discounts that will be implemented alongside the pricing structure – most users of facilities might be required to pay a small increase, where other groups, such as the elderly, there will be no change.
- 5. Work programme for the Community Centres Sub Committee**
An updated work programme was presented at the meeting – the work programme will now be the main topic of discussion in future sub committee meetings.
The section on publicity and promotions was discussed – this task will be implemented once the pricing and lettings policy is finalised and further discussions will take place on what form this publicity will take – for example – a themed brochure on the different types of centres.
Cllr Grayshon requested for Morley Town Hall and Blackburn Hall to be listed on the film locations website to be used as future locations for TV / film programmes.
