Project Summary
<p>The funding would pay for the resurfacing the length of the foot path that runs through the green space on Ley Lane. Currently, sections of the path have worn away leaving holes exposing the base layer. If left, these could become a trip hazard.</p> <p>As part of an initiative to reduce ASB and turn the field to turn it in to a useable green pace, Ley Lane has recently received funding to install a new football pitch and posts, fitness equipment and work with Breeze to carry out a range of engagement activities with youths in the area.</p> <p>This investment has helped to improve community spirit. ASB is down and the field has being used by local residents. The local schools in the area have started to use the field on a regular basis and have held football tournaments on it.</p>
