c) Public safety

Health & Safety and fire risk assessments will be kept and reviewed at least annually. The assessments will be produced for inspection at the request of an authorised officer.

All exit doors will be accessible, open easily, and exit routes will be maintained.

Written records of all accidents and safety incidents involving members of the public will be kept. These will be made available at the request of an authorised officer.

The Licensee will ensure that there is a procedure for the safe evacuation of disabled persons. Staff will be trained in the procedure.

Electrical installations will be inspected on a periodic basis by a suitably qualified and competent person and the records/

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certificates made available at the request of an authorised officer

There will be a suitably trained first aider on duty at all times that the premises are open to members of the public

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No nuisance will be caused by noise or vibration emanating from the premises. Licensable activities will be conducted and the facilities for licensed activities will be designed and operated so to prevent the transmission of audible noise or perceptible vibration through the fabric of the building.

Clear and legible notices will be displayed at exits, car parks and other circulatory areas requesting patrons to leave the premises having regard to the needs of local residents.

Bottles will not be placed in any external receptacle after 23.00 and before 07.00

e) The protection of children from harm

The Licensee's staff will ask for proof of age from any person appearing to be under the age of 21 who attempts to purchase alcohol at the premises.
